






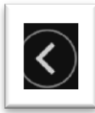
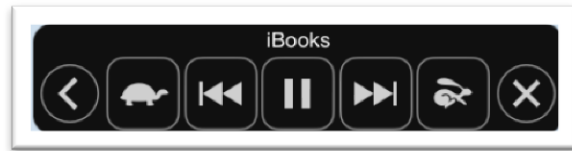
iOS 8... Speak Screen Text-to-Speech Feature



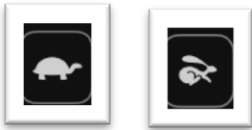
Speak Screen on an iOS 8, or above, iDevice provides an easy access to have the text on the screen read. As well you can control the reading speed, pausing and rewinding or forward location.

<p>To activate Speak Screen open Settings.</p>	
<p>Select <i>General</i> on the left hand pane. Then select <i>Accessibility</i> on the right.</p>	
<p>Select <i>Speech</i>.</p>	
<p>Turn on, slide to the right, the toggle button beside <i>Speak Screen</i>.</p> <p>Note: <i>Speak Selection</i> must also be on, as shown.</p> <p>Close Settings and open <i>iBooks</i>.</p>	
<p>Swipe down with two (2) fingers from top of screen.</p>	

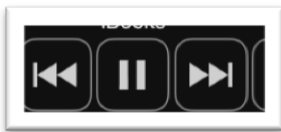
A control panel will appear and the iDevice will immediately start reading. The control can be moved with one finger but will minimize shortly after reading starts,



The far left arrow minimizes the control panel.



The Turtle and the Hare adjust reading speed.



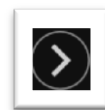
There are buttons to reverse, pause and forward reading position.

Note: Depending on what is being read, be it a digital PDF file, a file processed from Readiris or a Webpage etc... the forward and reverse buttons respond differently. They could jump from page to page, sentence to sentence or jump to groupings of text.



The X on the far right exits and stops the reading. Exiting the App does not stop the reading.

When the control panel has been minimized this arrow will appear on the side of the screen. Tap to open the Control Panel.
