#### Principal Report

Cash online will continue, we're at 56% for parents registered, will really promote it at the kindergarten level so it continues throughout the school years

MASC-we have submitted a request for funding but they are short on funding and will not be giving an artist in resident grant, we will wait and see if we can look into it later if council is in good standing financially and school budget is in good standing

School board has a theme of mercy and will be looking at this as a school

School is due for a climate survey, will be completed online by classes later in year

Transportation-some zones were declared safe zones to get children who had lost their bussing back on bussing, transportation has a new website, staff will review safety protocols for pick-up/drop-offs etc.

Sept 22 our school was not advised to be put on lockdown, we will be practicing our lockdowns next week

Phys Ed Document-5-8% of the document is the section related to sexual health, all staff have been asked to hold on teaching this, we already do a majority through Fully Alive and our Catholic Lens, examples are given in the book but do not have to be taught that way, material is being made right now about how to teach sexual health through the Catholic Lens, a pamphlet is being created to send home to parents
